## CONVENTION RULES

1. Members of the convention shall be in their seats five (5) minutes before each meeting.
2. A fine of one dollar (\$1.00) shall be assessed each delegate not in her seat and answering roll call at each meeting, or leaving before it is adjourned, unless excused by presiding officer. Payment of a fine shall be made to the Convention Secretary immediately following the close of the meeting. The Sgt-at-Arms will be instructed not to admit anyone during the roll call.
3. Workshops are considered a meeting of the Province Convention.
4. A Delegate addressing the Chair shall stand, and after being recognized, give her name, chapter, and city.
5. Main motions shall be written, signed by the maker of the motion and given to the Convention Secretary for the minutes.
6. Debate shall be limited to five (5) minutes for each speaker. The Province Chairman to designate who shall serve as time keepers, preferably, the tellers of this convention.
7. A voting member of the Convention may only speak twice on the same question, unless given consent by the assembly. She may not speak the second time if someone who has not spoken wishes the floor.
8. If a non-delegate wishes to speak, she asks permission from the chair, and if the assembly does not object, she may speak.
9. All votes during convention shall be taken by a voting card unless a re-vote is necessary. When a two-thirds (2/3) vote is required, it may be taken by standing without counting, unless there is a question as to the vote, in which case, it will be a standing count-off vote.
10. Pages shall pass all notes and messages during the meetings.
11. Appropriate business attire and/or Sorority apparel acceptable for meetings. No jeans/shorts allowed.
12. There shall be no smoking in the meeting room.
13. So that all may enjoy the Convention, delegates and visitors are requested to refrain from whispering.
14. During all business meetings, workshops, committee meetings, and functions, pagers and cellular phones shall be turned off and on vibrating mode.
